

INTEGRATION GUIDE

BLACKBOARD

With Blackboard® integration, students at your institution can access the PlaceU™ system through Blackboard to take placement tests.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Your sales representative must provide you with a **Key**, **Secret**, and **URL** before you can set up the PlaceU integration.

BLACKBOARD ADMINISTRATOR: REGISTER THE PLACEU LTI PROVIDER

The Blackboard System Administrator must register the PlaceU LTI provider before courses can be linked to PlaceU.

1. Log in to Blackboard as a system administrator.
2. Click **System Admin > Building Blocks > LTI Tool Providers > Register Provider Domain**.
3. Enter the following information.

Field	Value
Provider Domain	Enter the domain you were given and select Approved .
Default Configuration	Set Globally
Tool Provider Key	The key you were given.
Tool Provider Secret	The secret you were given.
Institution Polices	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Send user data over any connection • Role (or Constituency) in Course • Name • Email Addresses

4. Click **Submit**.

The PlaceU LTI provider is now registered for your instance of Blackboard.

INSTRUCTOR: ADD A LINK TO PLACEU

Blackboard instructors can add a PlaceU link to their classes after the PlaceU LTI provider has been registered.

1. Log in to Blackboard as an instructor and navigate to your course.
2. Click **Content**.
3. Click **Build Content > Web Link**.
4. Enter the following information.

Field	Value
Name	PlaceU
This link is to a Tool Provider	Selected
URL	The URL you were given.
Web Link Options > Open in New Window	Yes

NOTE: If your Blackboard administrator has not enabled the provider domain for your URL, a warning is displayed and the link will not work until it is enabled.

5. Click **Submit**.

PlaceU is now integrated in your Blackboard course.
