

Follow these recommendations to ensure academic integrity in online tests in your WebAssign course.

TIME LIMIT

Set a time limit for your test or assignment. A timer starts running when students begin the test and they have only the allotted time to complete it. This gives students less time to search for answers that they do not already know.

PASSWORD PROTECTION

Set a password to be sure your students cannot access any tests ahead of time. Students will not be able to begin the test until you share the password.

LOCKDOWN BROWSER

Prevent students from searching the internet while taking a test by using the LockDown Browser[®] tool.

LIMIT AVAILABILITY

Make tests available for only a short window of time. If available for a long period of time, students are given more opportunity to collaborate on each other's tests. A short window of availability forces students to begin their tests at the same time and prioritize their own work.

QUESTION POOLS

A question pool is a list of questions from which a specified subset of questions are randomly selected for each student's assignment, creating several different versions of the same test. This makes it more difficult to collaborate and more efficient for students to focus on their own work.

QUESTION VARIATION

If algorithmic questions are available and included in your exam, you can set these questions to generate different numerical values for each student. All students will be tested on the same concepts, but each will have different numbers in their questions and a different answer, so they cannot trade answers.

Do not allow any feedback on students' test performance until after the test is closed. Students that finish their tests early can use this feedback to assist other students still taking the test.
